2024 Eastern Michigan State Fair

Stock FWD Car/Minivan Rules

CAR TYPE

FWD 4 cylinder or V6, no ambulances, hearses, or limousines.

GENERAL

Vehicles must be stripped clean of any flammable materials, except for the driver's seat. All glass must be removed.

BODY

100% stock, no body shaping. You may remove metal, no adding metal anywhere unless stated. Must have an 8-inch hole in the trunk and hood. You may use a 9-gauge wire to secure the hood and trunk, 4 spots on each and 2 spots per door.

DRIVE TRAIN

Must be stock for that year, make, and model. If it didn't come with a carb from the factory, then it can't have one now. You may move computers or solenoids out of the way of danger.

GAS TANK

If the gas tank is behind the rear axle it must be put safely and securely into the back seat, and must be covered. No boat tanks. If the gas tank is in front of rear axle you may leave it in stock position, must add 2 extra ratchet straps to secure tank. Must have an on/off switch on the driver-side front pillar for any electric fuel pumps.

BATTERY

Must be moved to the passenger side floorboard. It must be safely mounted and covered.

BUMPERS

You may use any 80's or newer automotive bumper that is not chrome. Or you may use stock bumper. You may drill and hammer any bumper shock tubes. You may use a 9-gauge wire to tie the bumper to the frame of the vehicle. You are allowed to weld 2"x 6" ¼" strap, 2 per bumper, one on each side or you're allowed to weld the back of the bumper shock plate to the frame (Not both).

TIRES

Only DOT approved, may be tubed. Only on stock rims that fit the vehicle.

RADIATOR

Must be in stock location. May use 2 extra ratchet straps to hold the radiator and or spray foam.

SAFETY

Must have a window bar, or chain. Must have driver's door protection. You are allowed to skin the whole driver's side door, 2in max past the front or rear seam of the driver door. No sharp edges. You are allowed one side-to-side bar behind your seat no bigger than 6"x6". You are allowed one up-down bar behind your seat, 6"x6" max.

IMPORTANT- If it doesn't say you can, you can't!
